



WINEMAKING PHILOSOPHY

The grapes come from vineyards in the municipality of Serralunga d'Alba, at altitudes between 330 and 410 metres above sea level. The soils are of marine sedimentary origin, dating back to the "Piedmont Tertiary Basin", and are characterised by the presence of sedimentary calcareous-clay marl, alternating layers of marl and sand or sandstone. These soils feature the "Lequio Formation" characterised by evident layers of sand alternating with sandstone and marl. This terroir produces alcoholic wines, with important tannins, good structure and a long cellar life. Harvesting is followed by alcoholic fermentation, with maceration on skins for about 20 days. Malo-lactic fermentation takes place in steel. The wine then ages in oak barrels up to 24 months.

TASTING NOTES

Colour: red, tending towards garnet.

Bouquet: intense and complex, with notes of dried flowers, like rose and violet, as well as vanilla and tobacco.

Palate: dry and warm, with good body. The long finish reveals ripe fruit and berries, along with balsamic notes.

90 (02/2021) Vite Colte is a premium line including three commune-designate Baroli. The Serralunga bottling comes from various vineyards in the district ranging between 330 to 410 metres above sea level and is aged in small oak barrels. Dark forest fruit is tinged with leather and tar in this robust, sombre red. It's very structured, with thick chewy tannins requiring some time to loosen up. The finish trails off with hints of spice.
